

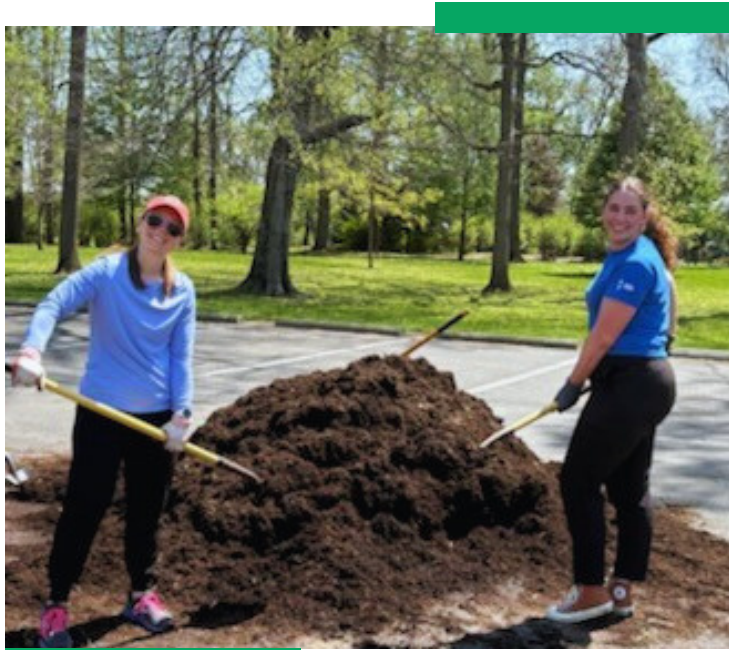

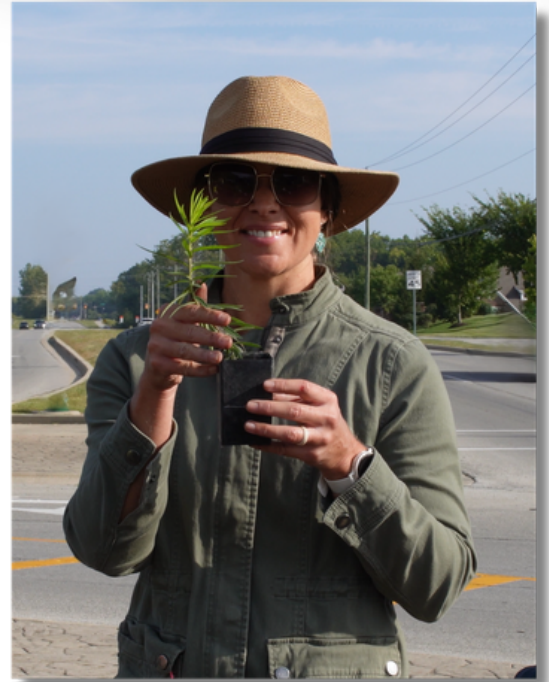


Why They **Chose to Care**
